Important Parent Information

Kindergarten & Up

SUMMER DAY CARE PAYMENT: Please continue to make your payment on **MONDAYS!** Remember that payment is **PAST DUE if not paid by Friday and a late payment fee will be added!** You will receive a statement of account on Friday. **Your account must be current on Monday morning.**

WE WILL NOT CARRY BALANCES ON ANY ACCOUNT!!!

Payment for Summer Activities: Please be aware of the **charges** for the special summer activities. **We recommend that you pay for the activities in your weekly check,** but cash payments will be recorded in Front Office.

☆ You must **advise Front Office** if you do **NOT** wish your child to participate in regular daily activities.

LATE PICK-UP: We close at 6:00pm. The front office leaves at 6:00pm. **It is mandatory that children be picked up BEFORE 6:00pm.** The following is the late fee schedule for late pick-ups:
6:00-6:05pm : \$10.00 Late fee will increase \$1.00/ minute after 6:05pm At or after 6:30pm: \$50.00

LUNCHESES: Students must bring a **LUNCH** each day to Summer Camp. We cannot refrigerate nor heat up lunches. Lunches need to be brought with your student each morning. **No lunch deliveries are allowed.**

Snack Bar: We will have a **SNACK BAR** open in the morning around 10:00 for students entering 1st grade and older to purchase snack food items (**Chips & Snacks \$2.00**). Students who do not purchase items from the snack bar will be given the regular snack from the school.

* **We encourage students to turn their snack bar money into the front office each morning.**

Clothing: Wear comfortable casual clothes this summer (**No Uniforms**). **PLEASE NO TANK TOPS-** Children will get sun burned! If sunscreen is needed, please apply to child before bringing to school.

Appropriate Shoes for School: Please be sure your child wears **tennis shoes** for playtime at school. **SANDALS and other shoes are NOT appropriate** for playground activities.

Personal Belongings: Please be sure **all** personal belongings are **MARKED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME and PLACED IN BACKPACK or TOTE BAG!** This includes swim suits, towels & all clothing.

Jewelry Worn to School: Children are NOT to wear jewelry to school. Because we are so busy with various activities, jewelry can easily get lost.

Toys Brought to School: **OLDER CHILDREN (completing 1st grade or older)** must use good judgment and have parental consent in bringing toys (especially electronic games & expensive toys) to school. *Label all toys with child's name.* Children who do not put toys or games away when asked will lose this privilege!

Bring at your own risk!!! Children completing Kindergarten may NOT BRING TOYS FROM HOME. **DESOTO PRIVATE SCHOOL WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR BROKEN OR LOST ITEMS.**

Summer Camp Requirements & Reminders

Tuition & Payments

- Tuition must be paid by 6:00 PM every Friday.
- A late fee is charged after 6:00 PM.
- Students cannot return to camp until the account is paid.
- Families who pay late will be required to pay at the beginning of each week going forward.

School Closing & Late Pick-Up Fees

- DeSoto Private School closes at 6:00 PM.
- \$10 late fee at 6:00 PM.
- After 6:05 PM, fee increases \$1 per minute.
- At or after 6:30 PM, fee becomes \$50.
- Repeated late pick-ups may result in dismissal from camp.

Required Forms (Found at the back of Summer Packet)

- All students must have the Field Trip Permission Slip completed.
- All students must have the Summer Behavior Expectations Form completed.
- These forms must be submitted before any student can attend Summer Camp.

Friday Field Trip (Kindergarten & Older) -

To attend the Altitude Trampoline Park trip:

- A waiver must be signed at: www.altitudecedarhill.com
- Students cannot jump without a completed waiver.
- Bring a water bottle every Friday.

Snack Bar (Kindergarten & Older)

- Kindergarten and Older Students may bring money for the Snack Bar each day.
- All items cost \$2.00 each.
- Students must turn their money into the office each morning.

Daily Requirements

- Students must bring a lunch every day.
- No drop-offs, no deliveries — lunch must come with the student at morning drop-off.
