SUMMER DAY CARE PAYMENT: Please continue to make your payment on **MONDAYS!** **Remember that payment is PAST DUE if not paid by Friday and a late payment fee will be added!** You will receive a statement of account on Friday. **Your account must be current on Monday mornings.**

WE WILL NOT CARRY BALANCES ON ANY ACCOUNT!!!

LATE PICK-UP: We close at 6:00pm. The front office leaves at 6:00pm. **It is mandatory that children be picked up BEFORE 6:00pm.** The following is the late fee schedule for late pick-ups:
6:00-6:05pm : \$10.00 Late fee will increase \$1.00/ minute after 6:05pm At or after 6:30pm: \$50.00

Payment for Summer Activities: Please be aware of the **charges** for the special summer activities. **We recommend that you pay for the activities in your weekly payment,** but cash payments will be recorded in Front Office.

☆ **You must advise Front Office if you do NOT wish your child to participate in regular daily activities.**

LUNCHES: Students must bring a **LUNCH** each day to Summer Camp. We cannot refrigerate nor heat up lunches. Lunches need to be brought with your student each morning. **No lunch deliveries are allowed.**

Clothing: Wear comfortable casual clothes this summer (No Uniforms). **Tank tops should NOT be worn.** Children will get sun burned! If sunscreen is needed, please apply to child before bringing to school.

Appropriate Shoes for School: Please be sure your child wears **TENNIS SHOES** for playtime at school. **Sandals and other shoes are NOT appropriate** for playground activities.

SPLASH Days: We set up wading pools for children to enjoy on "Splash Days". Children will need to bring a **Swimsuit & Towel** (labeled with name) in a bag.

Personal Belongings: Please be sure **all** personal belongings are **MARKED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME and PLACED IN BACKPACK or TOTE BAG!** This includes swim suits, towels and all clothing.

Jewelry Worn to School: Children are **NOT** to wear jewelry to school. Because we are so busy with various activities, jewelry can easily get lost.

Park If You Need to Come in School: Please be sure to park in one of the parking spaces provided if you need to come into the building. The two lanes are our "express" lanes to expedite movement into school.

Toys Brought to School: Please do **NOT** allow preschool children to bring toys to school. The school will NOT be responsible for lost toys or games.

COMMUNICATION IS SO IMPORTANT: As always, you are encouraged to send a note to the **Executive Board** regarding any concerns or questions which need to be addressed.

Summer Camp Requirements & Reminders

Tuition & Payments

- Tuition must be paid by **6:00 PM** every Friday.
- A **late fee** is charged after 6:00 PM.
- Students **cannot return to camp** until the account is paid.
- Families who pay late will be required to **pay at the beginning of each week** going forward.

School Closing & Late Pick-Up Fees

- DeSoto Private School **closes at 6:00 PM**.
- **\$10 late fee** at 6:00 PM.
- After **6:05 PM**, fee increases **\$1 per minute**.
- At or after **6:30 PM**, fee becomes **\$50**.
- Repeated late pick-ups may result in **dismissal from camp**.

Required Forms (Found at the back of Summer Packet)

- All students must have the **Field Trip Permission Slip** completed.
- All students must have the **Summer Behavior Expectations Form** completed.
- These forms must be submitted **before any student can attend Summer Camp**.

Tuesday Field Trip (Preschool) -

- A **waiver must be signed** at: www.playtopiausa.com
- Students **cannot attend** without a completed waiver.

Splash Days: What to Bring

- Swimsuit & towel
- **Label everything** — child's name on swimsuit, towel, and bag
- Send items **in a bag with your child's name**
- A **plastic grocery bag** is helpful for wet swimsuits after splashing
- We will **change the students here** at school

Daily Requirements

- Students must **bring a lunch every day**.
- No drop-offs, no deliveries — lunch must come with the student at morning drop-off.
- Students must wear **tennis shoes and socks every day**.
- **No sandals**
